### Day 1: Singapore - Kuala Lumpur

### Day 2: Kuala Lumpur - Langkawi

Enjoy breakfast on board as the train travels through the rural western towns of Malaysia.

Following lunch, there is a choice of enticing excursions.

The first option is to join a boat cruise to one of Langkawi's most beautiful beaches. Enjoy easy relaxation by reconnecting with nature and sampling wellness activities. Unwind with yoga, a sound bath and a massage, take a dip in the ocean or nearby swimming pool, and enjoy tropical fruit and drinks. Continue on with a boat ride through the narrow channels of Kilim Geoforest Park, where mangrove forests meet coastal karst in an otherworldly natural landscape.

Your second option opts for an adventurous discovery of Perlis Geopark. Embark on a cycle ride through breathtaking landscapes and incredible wildlife before entering an atmospheric former tin mine.

Lastly, your third option immerses you in the rich art and culture of Perlis. Learn to make your own batik, visit the personal collection of antique enthusiast and prepare our own afternoon tea in a traditional Malaysian coffee shop.

Returning to the train, an evening of lively celebrations with local entertainers awaits in the Bar Car, accompanied by a delicious dinner.

## Day 3: West coast line - Butterworth

Today you arrive in Penang Island, Malaysia's cultural melting pot, where you have a choice of excursions.

The first is a discovery of the culinary art of Peranakan cooking, where you will visit a spice shop and traditional grocery stores to purchase herbs and vegetables, before trying your hand at making some enticing local dishes with a cooking lesson in the magnificent Art Deco-influenced Eythrope Bungalow.

The second suits those with a passion for culture and art, taking you to Georgetown Old Quarter to see stunning temples, a contemporary studio and an opera and puppet house.

Lastly, you can choose to explore independently. Armed with a map, a tri-shaw and a driver, navigate Georgetown's picturesque streets at your own pace. Your driver will take you anywhere you want to go, from grand attractions to hidden corners.

Rejoin the train at Butterworth for lunch and a leisurely afternoon on board.

A final celebratory evening beckons with irresistible cuisine and entertainment. If you're still up shortly after midnight, you'll glimpse Kuala Lumpur as the train passes through.

## Day 4: Johor - Singapore

Enjoy breakfast in your cabin as the train travels through the southernmost Malaysian state of Johor before crossing the Straits and arriving back into Singapore.
