Day 1: Delhi

On arrival at Delhi Airport, you'll be greeted and taken to the luxurious Taj Palace Hotel.

Day 2: Delhi to Shimla

Explore Amritsar, a cultural and spiritual center for the Sikh community. Founded in the 16th century by Guru Ram Das Ji, the city's history is rich with Sikh tradition and heritage. Experience the majesty of the Golden Temple, a sacred site showcasing divine devotion.

In the evening, witness the tranquil Palki ceremony at the Golden Temple.

Enjoy a two-night stay at the luxurious Hotel Taj Swarna.

Day 6: Amritsar

After breakfast, return to the magnificent Golden Temple. Admire its intricate marble sculptures and beautiful interiors while observing cleansing rituals by the tranquil waters surrounding it.

Following, explore the peaceful gardens of Jallianwala Bagh, home to a memorial honoring the victims of the tragic 1919 massacre, a reminder of resilience in the face of adversity.

Continue your historical journey with a visit to the Partition Museum, offering insights into India's partition in 1947 and its lasting impact on people's lives.

In the afternoon, enjoy an exclusive trip to the India-Pakistan border at Atari for the captivating flag-lowering ceremony. Witness soldiers from both sides engage in a spirited display of precision and patriotism in this mesmerizing spectacle.

Day 7: Amritsar to Delhi

Today, board a flight from Amristar and return to Delhi.

Enjoy an overnight stay at Hotel Taj Palace.

Day 8: Delhi

Delhi, one of the world's oldest cities, is bustling and vibrant, renowned for its traditional markets.

The captivating city tour explores this lively metropolis, visiting landmarks such as the Raj Ghat memorial to Mahatma Gandhi, Humayun's Tomb - a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and the impressive Qutab Minar, the tallest brick minaret globally at 238 feet (73 meters), dating back to 1368.

Later in the evening, board the luxurious *Deccan Odyssey*. Relax in your comfortable private cabin and enjoy the welcoming ambiance of the Bar Lounge Car as you begin your rail journey.

Enjoy dinner aboard the train as your journey continues across India.

Day 9: Fatephur Sikri & Agra Fort

After breakfast, visit the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Fatehpur Sikri. This red sandstone town, known as a 'ghost city', was abandoned in 1585 shortly after being built due to water scarcity.

In the afternoon, your journey takes you to Agra Fort, a magnificent structure dominating the skyline. It served as the main residence for Mughal emperors until 1638, with its extensive red sandstone walls stretching for 2.5 km and housing numerous palaces and mosques.

Day 10: Agra

Begin your day at sunrise to avoid the crowds while you visit the breathtaking Taj Mahal, a magnificent white marble structure situated on the south bank of the Yamuna river.

Completed in 1648 by Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan, it serves as a mausoleum for his beloved wife, Mumtaz Mahal. This iconic building, renowned worldwide, took 22 years and 20,000 artisans to construct. Its beauty and symbolism make it a remarkable testament to enduring love and exceptional craftsmanship.

Afterwards, weather permitting, enjoy breakfast in the gardens of the Taj Kema hotel, offering a stunning view of the Taj Mahal in the distance.

Rejoin the *Deccan Odyssey* for lunch as you continue your journey towards the state of Rajasthan.

Day 11: Jaipur

Enjoy breakfast as you arrive into Jaipur, the vibrant 'Pink City' of Rajasthan. You'll begin by visiting the awe-inspiring Amber Fort, including the stunning Hall of Mirrors.

After lunch at a local restaurant, your exploration continues with a tour of the Jantar Mantar Observatory, the grand City Palace, and the exquisite Hawa Mahal, or Palace of Winds. This delicate yet enduring monument, constructed entirely of pink sandstone in 1799, allowed royal ladies to discreetly observe daily life.

If time allows, you'll also explore a renowned fabric market before returning to the train to freshen up.

In the evening, dine at the elegant Rambagh Palace Hotel.

Day 12: Udaipur

Relax in the morning aboard the train, soaking in the beauty of India's landscapes and culture.

Later, you will have the chance to attend a talk on Indian culture before reaching Udaipur, also known as the 'City of Lakes' or 'Venice of the East'. Here, you'll discover a mesmerizing blend of stunning lakes and majestic palaces from the Rajput era.

In the afternoon, admire the breathtaking beauty of the Lake Palace, a marvel made entirely of marble situated on its own island in the shimmering waters of Pichola Lake.

Following, visit the majestic City Palace, showcasing medieval grandeur.

Day 13: Mumbai

Arrive in Mumbai and bid farewell to the *Deccan Odyssey* as you transfer to the prestigious Taj Mahal Palace & Tower Hotel for a luxurious two-night stay.

Enjoy the stunning views of the Arabian Sea and the iconic Gateway of India, with a legacy of exceptional hospitality spanning over a century.
