And one great thing about this train: there are 4 cabins for solo use with no single supplement. Great for a family of couple and solo travelers. Call early to book!

Itinerary

Day 1: Edinburgh – Boat of Garten

The *Belmond Royal Scotsman* departs Edinburgh early afternoon and travels north through the former Kingdom of Fife, then up into the dramatic scenery of the Highlands.

In the evening, indulge in a convivial dinner followed by entertainment in the Observation Car. *The Royal Scotsman* reaches the village of Boat of Garten, its stabling point for the night.

Day 2: Boat of Garten — Dundee

After breakfast, travel by coach to Rothiemurchus Estate in the heart of the Cairngorms National Park where broadcaster and food anthropologist Ghillie Basan teams with her son Zeki to teach everything you need to know about Scottish wildlife and Highland survival skills.

Enjoy a barbecue lunch served while Ghillie shares the story about how she came to live in the Cairngorms and was elected a Food Ambassador for Scotland. Join her by the fire for an insightful food and kombucha pairing as she showcases the succulent seasonal produce of the Highlands.

Return to the train in Carrbridge for a relaxing afternoon as the train travels through Inverness and Keith. One option is to visit Strathisla Distillery, the oldest and one of the most picturesque working distilleries in the Highlands, and home to the malt which is incorporated into one of Scotland's most famous blends, Chivas Regal.

Along the coast, soak up the spectacular panoramas on the way south through Aberdeenshire

and Angus. Enjoy a splendid gala dinner and some lively jazz music before returning to your cabin.

Day 3: Return to Edinburgh

After breakfast, the train leaves Dundee towards Edinburgh's Waverley Station where your journey ends.
