Itinerary

Day 1: Vancouver

Day 2: Vancouver to Kamloops

Day 3: Kamloops to Banff

Day 4: Private Banff Sightseeing

Begin the morning with included breakfast, after which you will enjoy a private sightseeing tour of Banff. Visit Bow Falls, Lake Minnewanka, Surprise Corner and the Hoodoos. Banff Gondola is included. The rest of the day is free.

Enjoy a day at leisure in Banff.

Day 6: Private tour of Banff to Lake Louise

Enjoy breakfast (included) before you meet your private transfer driver to be whisked away to the stunning Lake Louise. Often described as the crown jewel of the Canadian Rocky Mountains, the striking turquoise waters of Lake Louise, Alberta, are perhaps the most photographed in all of Canada.

Enjoy a Traditional English High Tea with champagne while enjoying the scenic views of the lake.

Your evening is at leisure.

Accommodations: Fairmont Gold Lakeview Room, <u>Fairmont Château Lake Louise.</u>(B, high tea)

Day 7: Lake Louise

Enjoy a day at leisure in Lake Louise.

Accommodations: Fairmont Gold Lakeview Room, Fairmont Château Lake Louise (B)

Day 8: Private tour Lake Louise to Jasper

Private tour of Banff and Jasper National Parks via the Icefields Parkway. Highlights are Bow Lake, the Columbia Icefield, Athabasca Falls, and a ride on an Ice Explorer.

Arrive in Jasper early this evening.

Accommodations: Junior Suite Lakeview, Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge (B, L)

Day 9: Jasper

Enjoy a free day in Jasper.

Accommodations: Junior Suite Lakeview, Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge (B)

Day 10: VIA Rail from Jasper to Toronto

This evening, a private transfer will take you to the Jasper train station, where you will begin your four-day VIA Rail journey on <u>The Canadian</u> across the Prairie Provinces and Ontario, with all meals on board included.

Overnight on *The Canadian* in Prestige Class. (B, L, D)

Days 11-12: Onboard VIA Rail

Continue your rail journey across Canada to Toronto. Overnight on <u>The Canadian</u> in Prestige Class. (B, L, D)

Day 13: Toronto

Arrive in Toronto on <u>The Canadian</u> this morning. A private transfer will take you from the station to the <u>Four Seasons Hotel Toronto</u>, for a two-night stay in a Deluxe Room. (B)

Day 14: Private tour of Niagara Falls

Enjoy a full-day private tour to <u>Niagara Falls</u>. Included is a boat tour to the base of Horseshoe Falls. Return to Toronto early this evening to stay overnight. (IMAX Theatre or Journey Behind the Falls is substituted when the Niagara Falls boat tour is not operating.) Overnight at the Four Seasons Hotel Toronto in a Deluxe Room. (B, L)

Day 15: Toronto

Your Trans-Canada Rail Adventure ends with checkout from the Four Seasons Hotel Toronto and a private sedan transfer to the airport. (B)
