Itinerary

Day 1: London

Board the *Belmond British Pullman*, sister train to the *Venice Simplon-Orient-Express*, at London Victoria station this morning. Take your seat and await a delicious Bellini brunch as you travel through the Kent countryside.

After a transfer, meet the *Venice Simplon-Orient-Express* in Calais, France. Step inside the legendary carriages and settle into your private cabin.

As the sun begins to descend, dress to impress and head to one of the beautifully restored restaurant cars for dinner. Perhaps enjoy a drink in the Bar Car and listen to the resident pianist before retiring for the evening. Your cabin has been transformed into a cozy bedroom.

(Optional to board in Paris rather than London. Note, for those boarding in Paris: Departure is about 10 p.m. with dinner served immediately after. Arrive dressed for dinner.)

Day 2: Verona Arrival

Wake up to a beautiful vista of Swiss lakes and majestic mountains, and enjoy breakfast in your cabin at a time to suit you. Later on, a three-course lunch is served in one of the restaurant cars.

Enjoy time at leisure on board, exploring the carriages with their antique details or sipping a coffee in the Bar Car. All too soon we arrive in Verona, where your journey comes to a close late afternoon.
